Case Study: Expenses Concerns

A four partner dental practice was investigated by HMRC due to their concerns over certain expenses claimed in the accounts.

Following a brief exchange of correspondence, the case involved an exhaustive meeting with an HMRC inspector raising very specific queries on the expenses attributable to both the partnership and the individual personal expenses claimed. The investigation centred almost exclusively on this area and was only settled after the accountant prepared a detailed analysis of expenses claimed over a five year period.

With only minor additions the fees charged for this enquiry amounted to £8,000.
